

Claudia Rossig received her medical degree at the University of Luebeck in Germany, then joined the Department of Pediatric Hematology and Oncology of University Children's Hospital Muenster, Germany, as a Clinical Fellow. Between 1998 and 2000, funded by a grant by Deutsche Krebshilfe e.V., she was a Postdoctoral Fellow with Malcolm Brenner in the Center for Cell and Gene Therapy, Baylor College of Medicine in Houston, USA.
